Surveyed to Gates Wilcox on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of September 1839 by virtue of his Warrant for 181 acres dated the 31<sup>st</sup> day of August 1839 Containing one hundred and eighty one acres and fifty two perches with allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c ~
