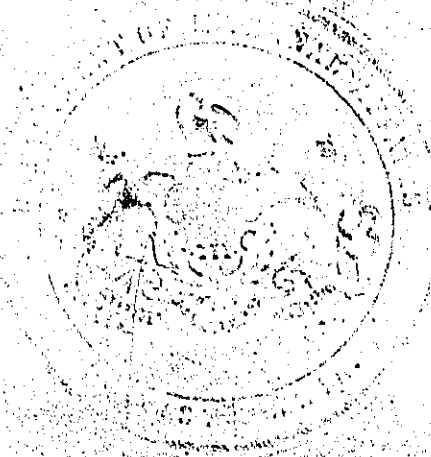


Situated on the Clearfield Creek in White Township Cambria County, formerly part of Huntingdon County Surveyed by William OrKeeff Esq^r. D.S. on the 17th day of Sept^r A.D. 1820 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Daniel Boggs, dated 7th March 1794 and in virtue of an improvement and actual settlement made in the Spring of 1807. and resurveyed the 4th day of November A.D. 1841. Containing Two hundred and Ninety six acres and Ninety one perches, and the usual Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c.
