 vey'd to Ezekiel Harlan a Certain Tract of Land on a branch of Doe Run in the County

 the s^d Ezekiel Harlan Thence East by y^e s^d Ezekiel Harlan's Land 222 perches to a
 post Thence North by Vacant Land 211 perches to a Black Oak Thence West by Vacant
 Land 137 perches to a post Thence South South West by Vacant Land 228 perches
 to y^e place of Beginning Containing 224 acres wth allowance of Six p^{er}ches
 Survey'd y^e 26th of May 1715
