In pursuance of a Warrant from the Proprietaries of Pennsylvania granted to Daniel Martin the 6th day of September 1762 Resurvey'd the 20th day of March 1801 agreeable to the old lines of Cor^r and appear to contain Forty two acres and 92 perches and the allowance of six ym. Cent for Roads &c
