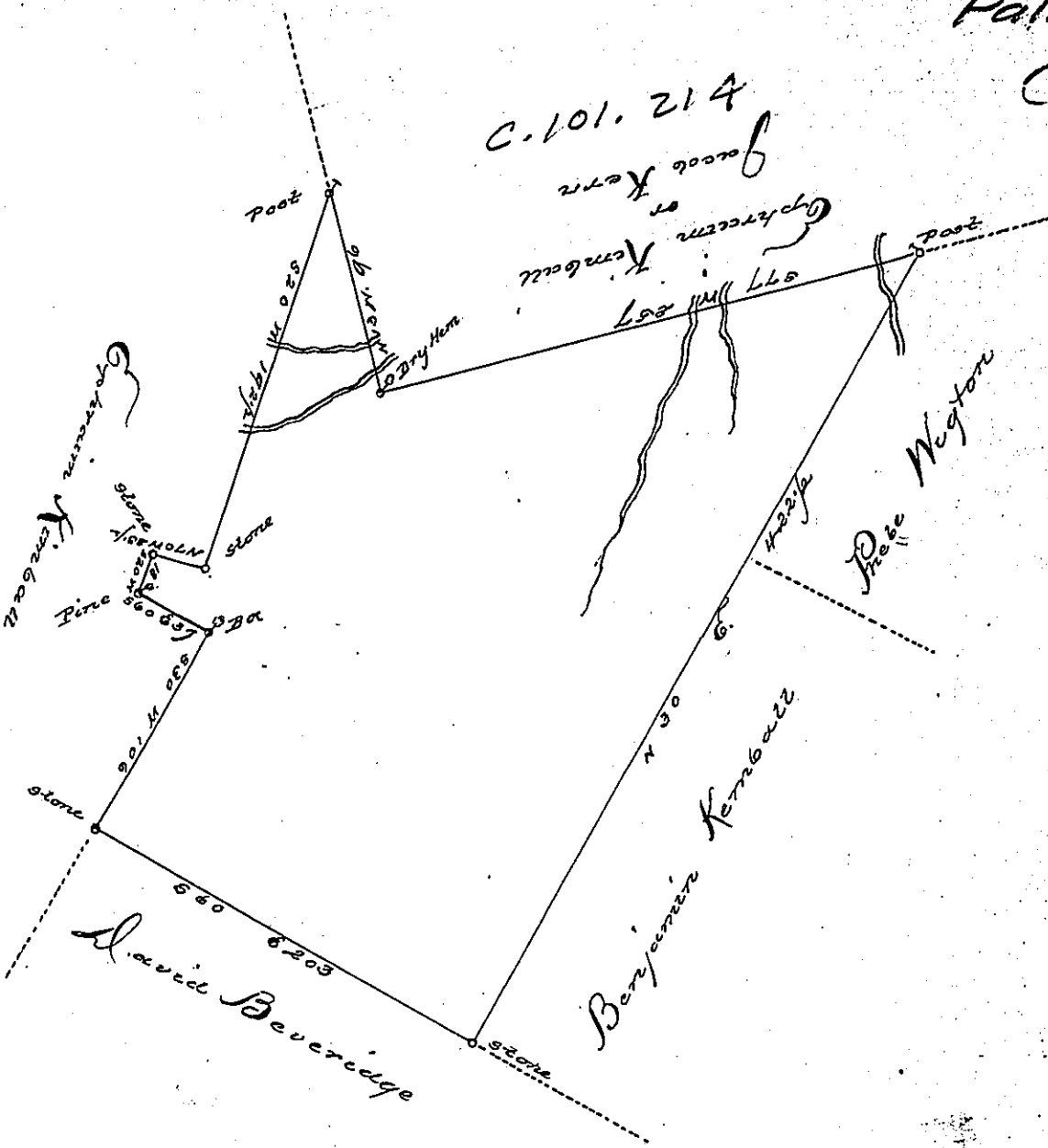


Lackawaxen
