



These May Certify that by Virtue of a Warrant from The Commissioners of Property to me directed bearing date the 18th day of the 12th Month 1701-2 I Resurveyed to Morgan James a certain tract of Land Situate in New Town in the County of Chester Beginning at a Post being the Corner of Rees Ertle's Band then so 55 West 415 perches in the Line of the said Rees Ertle to a Wall-thence N: 24 W 38 perches to a poste being the Corner of John Cutwaller's Band thence Nor. 53 East in the said Cutwaller's Line 140 perches to a Chesnut thence N: 24 W: 50 perches to a white oak thence north 55 East 275 Perches to a Spanish oak thence South 24 East 97 perches to the first mentioned post Containing 200 Acres

Also of Resurvey to the said Morgan James a Lot Containing ten Acres Now in the Possession ~~of John Cutwaller~~ of John Cutwaller Beginning at a black oak by New Town Great Road thence North 24 degrees west by the S^d Road fifteen perches and a half to a white oak by the S^d Road thence North 53 deg: East 140 perches to a post thence South 24 deg: East seven perches and a half to a poste thence South 50 deg: West 142 perches to the first mentioned black oak Resurveyed the 11 of the 1st month 1701-2 By me Isaac Taylor Surveyor of the County of Chester
