 ship in the County of Franklin Containing the Quantities therein  
 respectively inserted - No 1 includes the former & present  
 Claim & Improvements of Philip Davis, who has a warrant in  
 the Name of James Davis for 50 Acres Dated 20<sup>th</sup> February  
 1754 under this Warrant Philip Davis claims the Tract or part  
 of the Tract No 1. Tho it does not to one appear clearly located  
 here, but rather on Land at some distance - The Tract No 2  
 is claimed by David Collins under a Warrant to Alexander  
 Forgy & Andrew Forgy Dated 26<sup>th</sup> October 1773, and the  
 same is now also claimed by Philip Davis under a War-  
 rant transferred to him by John Schweitzer Dated 29<sup>th</sup> June  
 1773. - Survey'd December 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> 1785 by Order of B<sup>d</sup>  
 Property Nov<sup>r</sup> 1788 the 37<sup>a</sup> 63<sup>p</sup> Adjudged to David Collins  
 To John Bukens Esq<sup>r</sup> }
