The above is a Draught of a Tract of Land situate on Thompsons Run in Washington County Surveyd March 21st 1785 in pursuance of a Certificate said to be from the Commissioners from the state of Virginia ^{who was} appointed to settle the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongahala Yohogania and Ohio granted to Richard Evens Called Copora hill Containing 262 acres and 140 perches --- Copy of Certificate) David Redick D.S. Virginia Surveyors Office Yohogania County Richard Evens produced a Certificate from the Commissioners appointed to settle Titles and Grant Unpatented Lands within the Counties of Monongahala Yohogania and Ohio in these words --- We the Commissioners appointed to adjust the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongahala Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Richard Evens is entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Yohogania on the Waters of Thompsons Run to include his improvement made thereon in the year 1772 Given under our hands at Coxs Fort the 23d day of June 1780 and in the fourth year of the Commonwealth which Certificate I find Entered on the Record in this Office Book No 1 Lots 84 Entry 648 Given under my hand and Seal this 4 day of March 1785. now Allegheny County John Culkens Esq: Secy Seal B. Johnson
