



Situate in Porter Township Huntingdon County containing one hundred five acres 65 perches & the usual allowance the same being part of a tract of land originally surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Joseph Jacobs Dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May 1763 the whole survey was then said to contain 105 1/2 acres & the usual allowance this part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract the 4<sup>th</sup> day of Aug<sup>r</sup> 1839
