



In Pursuance of an Order from the Secretary there was surveyed for John Hay a Certain Lot of Ground for the use of a Tann-yard, situate on the West side of Detroit Spring in Middleton Township in Cumberland County, Beginning at a Post on the bank of said spring thence running Westward Parallel with the North Street of the Town of Carlisle by other Lands of the Honourable The Proprietaries Three Hundred and forty feet, and Southward by Water Street at the East end of the said Town one Hundred and Twenty feet, and Eastward by other Lands of the Proprietaries Three Hundred and Twenty feet to the Bank of the said Spring and down the same the several Courses thereof one Hundred and sixty five feet to the place of beginning Containing three fourths of an Acre and thirty one and one Half Perches ~
