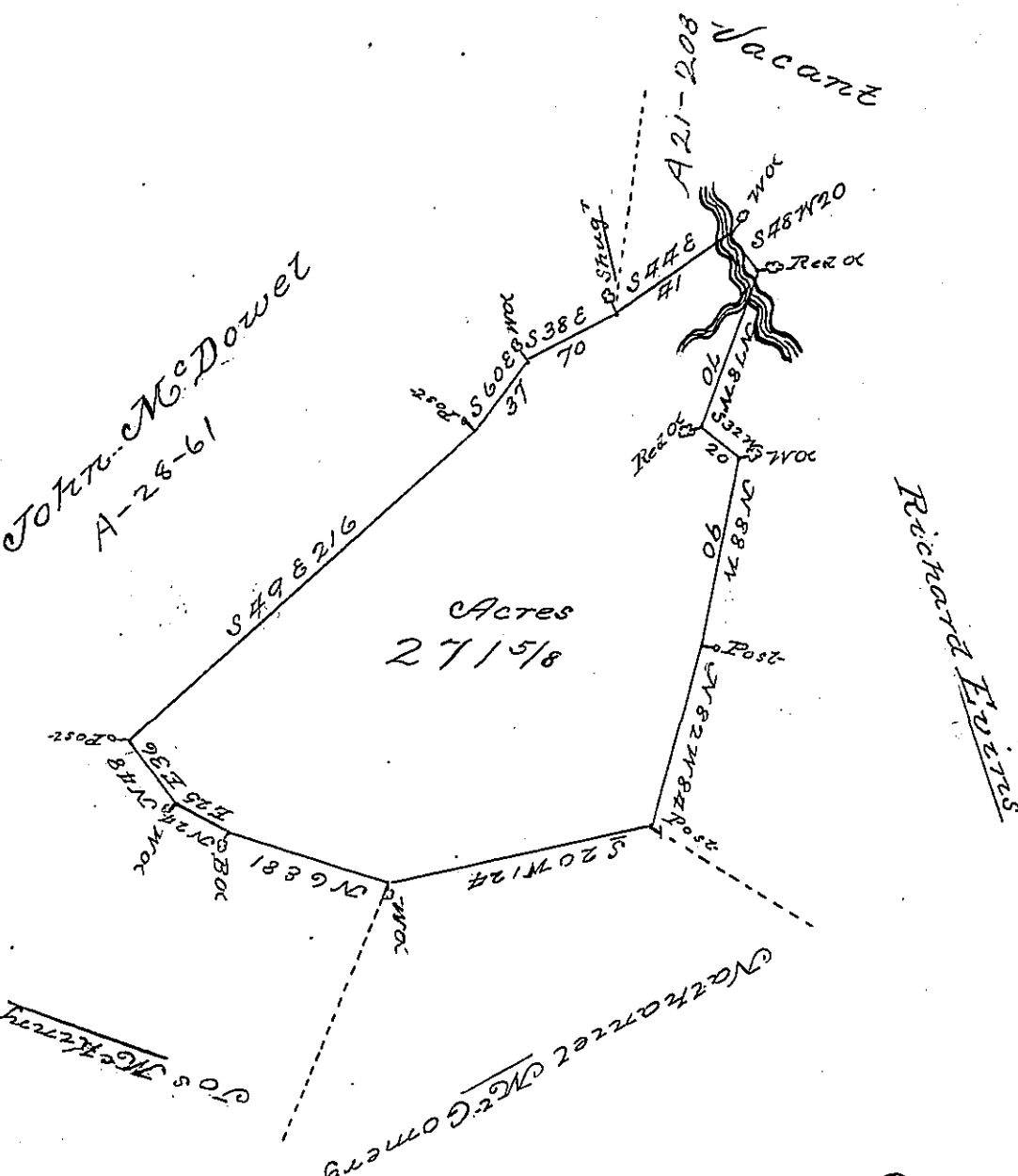

True Copy of the Certificate

Virginia Surveyors Office Yokogania County Produced a Certificate from the Comr. appointed to settle Titles and grant unpatented Lands in the Counties of Yokogania Monrongsakala & Ohio In these words "We the Commissioners for adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in Yokogania & Monrongsakala & Ohio do Certify that Mary Berry is Entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in Yokogania County to Include his improvement made thereon in the year 1772 Given under our Hands the 23 day of June 1780 and in the fourth year of the Common Wealth of Pennsylvania Phil. Pendleton Test Jam. Inwin Secy. Pro Tem. Which Certificate I find entered on the Records of this Office Book No 1 Folio 85 Entry No 649 given under my Hand and seal this 14th day of April 1785
