



By Virtue of a warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries bearing date the ___ day of ___ Anno Dom^o I have Surveyed and Laid out George Cathey in the Township of Terns-borough in Lancaster County on the West side Susquehanna River Two hundred and forty six acres of Land with allowance of six 1/2 Cent Beginning at a Hickery standing by the side of Conegwenth Creek Thence North-west Eighty Six perches to a white-oak a Corner of Jno^o Mc Cormick's Land Then North East Fifty two perches to a white-oak Thence South Seventy two Degrees Easterly Sixty eight perches to a Hickery Thence North Seventy six degrees Easterly One hundred and forty six perches to a Beech standing on a small Branch thence Down the same near about Three hundred perches to a Spruce Tree a Corner of James M^o Connells Land Then South Seventy Degree Westerly one hundred and seventeen perches to a Locust ~~tree~~ stand on the side of D^o Creek Thence Traversing up the same near about Two hundred and forty perches to the place of Beginning Surveyed June 3^d 1737
