Was the 30th day of Decemb^r 1762 Surveyed by John Scull former Deputy Surveyor And Now Resurveyed the 23^d day of July 1801 for Jonas Rudy in Right of said Nicholas Buff the above described Tract of Land Situate in Bethel Township formerly Lancaster now Dauphin County containing one Hundred and fifteen Acres and 115 perches and Allowance agreeable to the old lines in order to correct an Error in the former Survey in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property dated the 15th day of July 1801
