



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Turnersburgh Township formerly Cumberland now Whiffin County containing Three Hundred Acres and 25 perches and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Part of a tract of land which appears Survey^d the 29th day of July 1769 - said to contain 208.88¹/₂ ac. in pursuance of an Order n^o. 1000 granted to Robert Wilson dated the 27th day of August 1766 September the 6th 1798 - Resurvey^d the Survey^d tract in the name of Adam Porter which appears to contain Two Hundred and Fifty eight Acres and 15 perches and the allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Land on the 7th day of Sept. 1798 Divided the Survey in the name of Robert Porter as above represented -
