



A Draft of part of a tract of Land Situate in Green Township Franklin County (formerly Letterkerry Township) Cumberland County containing one hundred and fourteen acres and one hundred and fifty three perches & allowance of Six per cent for Roads Being part of a Larger tract of 494<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> 34<sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> & all. Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted James Sharpe bearing date the 7<sup>th</sup> day of October 1765. Resurveyed and laid off the 6<sup>th</sup> day of December 1820.
