



A Draft of forty six acres and eighty four perches of land with six percent for Roads situate in Lack Township in Mifflin, late Cumberland, county which is part of a survey made 23rd December 1802 in pursuance of a Warrant to Thomas Beale dated 19th November 1787, and now 23rd May 1815 Resurveyed and corrected in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property granted to William Beale Esquire dated 16th January 1815. Note the dotted lines represent the original survey, (with the black lines) made on said Warrant, and the red lines represent lines made for John Hazlewood, on an order to which are now established as lines of this survey, by virtue of said order of the Board of Property.
