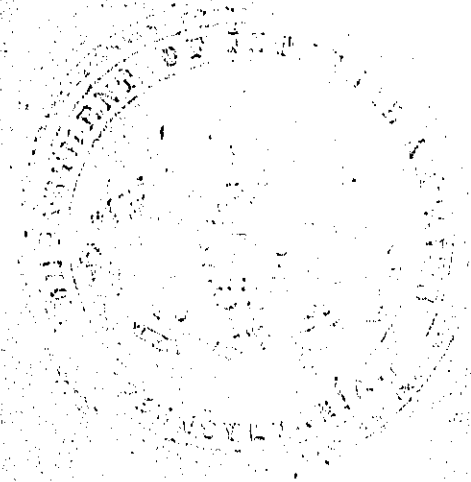


Captain M. Courtney 11<sup>th</sup> Lt. 4<sup>th</sup> Regt. and allowance

 into my hand (granted to William Whiteford the 14<sup>th</sup> of February 1787) he having pre-  
 viously had a survey made by my Deputy without informing him of M<sup>c</sup>Courtney's Warrant  
 and now incerts on holding the land, said Clunney had cleared a small part of the va-  
 cancy some years ago.
