



Situate in Warrington Township York County containing two hundred and nine acres, twelve perches and allowance of six per cent. Originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Jacob Wybright dated the 19th of October 1738. Resurveyed by George Stevenson then D.S. on the 2nd day of June 1762. for George Minchatt in pursuance of a Warrant of Re-survey, dated the 30th day of May 1761. Examined, corrected, and returned August 5th. 1822.
