



Sitticate in Manchester Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 11<sup>ac</sup> & 113<sup>perches</sup> and the usual accretions &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 190<sup>ac</sup> & 88<sup>perches</sup> and allowed &c. of Land, which was originally Surveyed by William Matthews late D.D. on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of the 3<sup>d</sup> Month 1765. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 150<sup>ac</sup> Granted to William Burney bearing date the 23<sup>d</sup> day of July 1762. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1809. And now at the request of the owner Henry Baumgartner the same is returned for confirmation the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1812
