



By Virtue of a Warrt. from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries bearing Date Twen-
 tieth Day of January Anno Domⁱⁿⁱ 1737 I have Surveyed and Laid out unto
 Finley McGrew on a small branch of Conewago Creek in the County of
 Lancaster on the west side Susquehanna River Three hundred and thirteen
 acres of Land with allow^{ance} of 6 1/2 Cent. Beginning at a Hickory a corner of
 William McGrews Land Thence by the said Land north Eight degrees Easterly
 Three hundred and seventy three perches to a post Thence north ten degrees West
 by one hundred and sixty perches to a post Thence south Eighty degrees
 West by two hundred perches to a White oak
 forty perches to a Black oak Thence south Eighty
 and seventy three perches to a post Thence so
 one hundred and twenty perches to the place
