



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Turney Patch Situate on the south side of the Frankston Branch of Juniata River about a mile below the mouth of Shavers Creek in Barré Township in the County of Bedford. Containing one hundred & forty six acres & the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 11<sup>th</sup> Day of September 1775 for William Lynn Senior in pursuance of an Order No 995. Dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1766.
