



Situate on the Heads of the East Branch of Little Juniata near the foot of the Alleghania Mountain Opposite John Mar's Gap in the Bald Eagle Ridge in Tyrone Township Huntington County Surveyed the first day of July 1788, in Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 1st day of September 1785

Bedford June 2, 1786

Note this Warrant calls for land joining Ethious Fowler on Spruce Creek, This being Appropriated by a Prior Right in the Name of Anthony Nagles. is the reason why it has been laid at the above place
