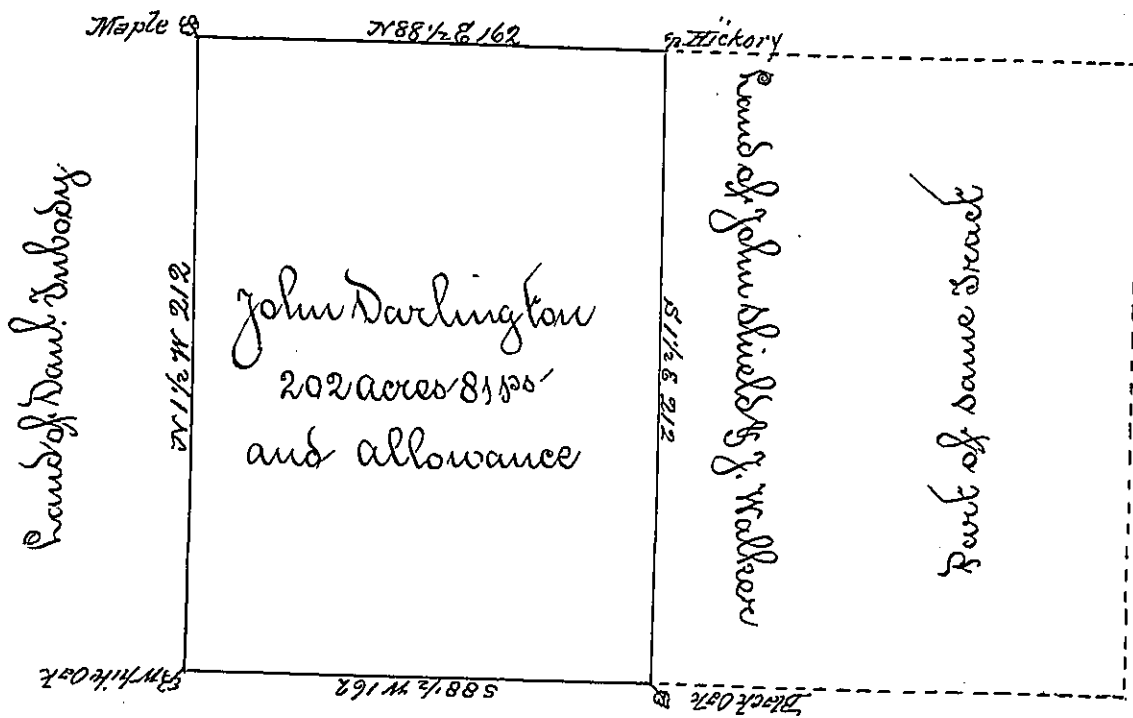


Land of John Price

The above is a draft of a survey made for John Darlington situate in Peachburg Township Mercer County, being the west end of a tract of land formerly surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Davis dated 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1794 and returned to the Land Office. Surveyed the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August 1829 containing two hundred and two acres and eighty one perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
