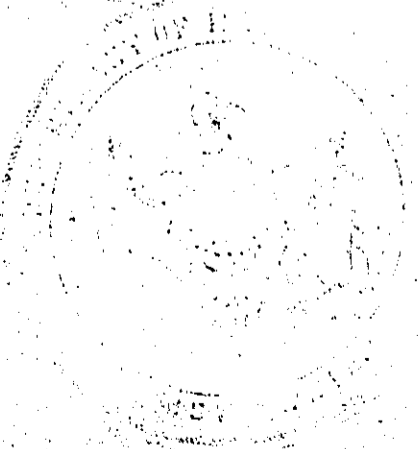


The above draft represents a tract of land surveyed November the 17<sup>th</sup> AD 1846 in pursu-  
 ance of a warrant granted to George Shuster dated September the 18<sup>th</sup> AD 1846 for 40 acres  
 of land unimproved situate in Big Beaver Township Beaver County adjoining lands as  
 above, containing thirty six acres and forty eight perches and allowance of six percent  
 To John Raporte D. G. Dawson S. Teye D.D.

Note Adam Lowryes Heires claim the above by an actual settlement and has it all  
 under fence but none cleared  
 Dawson S. Teye D.D.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the  
 Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made con-  
 formably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of  
 February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused  
 the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this  
 seventh day of September 1897.
