



By virtue of a Warrant dated at Philadelphia on the 16th Day of August Anno 1756, granted to Conrad Bean the above described Tract of Land situate in Haccoogy Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania containing fifty Eight Acres and Twelve Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at six per Cent for Decads was surveyed for Dewald Hoechlin, on the 31st Day of March Anno 1757. - The said Conrad Bean having sold his Right to the same unto the said Dewald Hoechlin.
