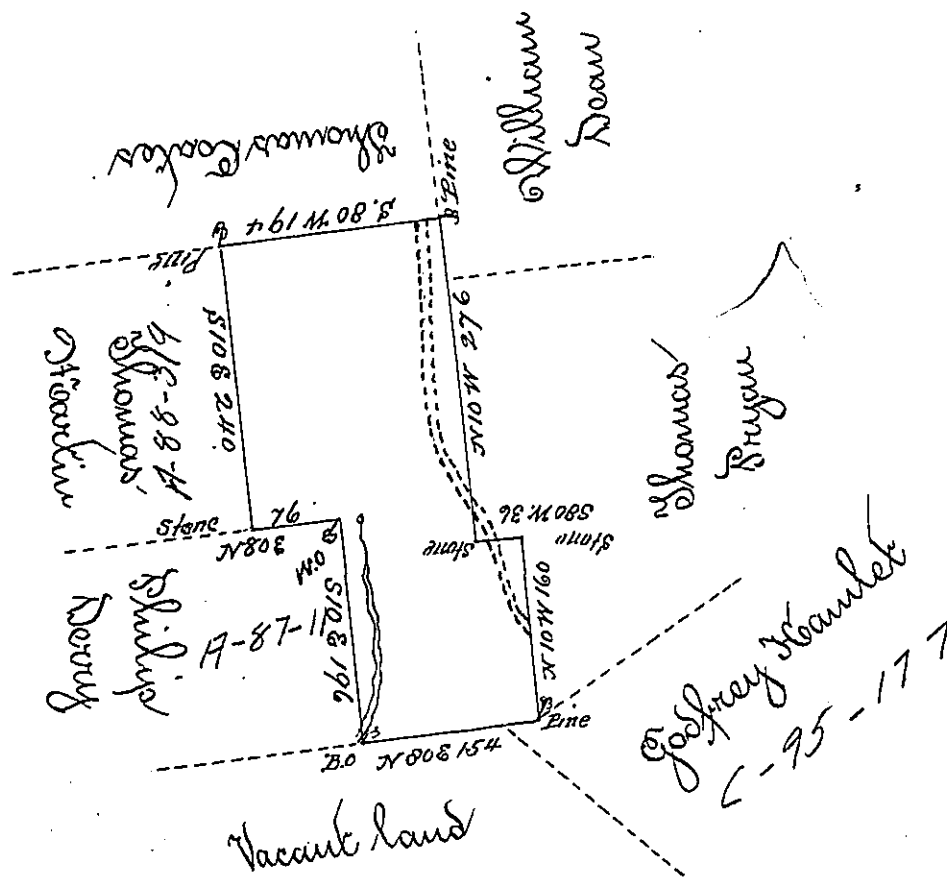


Penn Forest
