



The above is a Draught of a tract of land call'd Strawberry Hill Situate on Charliers Creek in Strabane Township Washington County, which said tract appears to have been surveyed for Michael Marshall the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November AD. 1769 in pursuance of an order No: 3625. dated 8<sup>th</sup> July 1769. That portion of said tract described by black lines and Courses and distances was resurveyed the 2<sup>th</sup> day of November 1822 for William Quail, the present owner and occupier, and Contains Two hundred and fifteen acres, one hundred and twenty five perches and allowance of six  $\frac{1}{2}$  c<sup>t</sup>. The residue of said tract, described by dotted lines and Charliers Creek is now owned by James Orr Esq<sup>r</sup>. and Daniel Moore of the Borough of Washington, Washington County and the heirs of Thomas Marshall of Strabane Township in said County &
