



Situate in Newbury Township York County containing fourteen Acres one hundred & twenty seven perches and allowance part of a larger tract of 20<sup>ac</sup> 5/8 & allowance of land surveyed by John Dorsyth Esq. then D.S. upon the 8<sup>th</sup> day of August 1790 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Samuel Keller for 50<sup>ac</sup> dated the 26<sup>th</sup> July 1790. Divided the 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 1829 for Elijah Jacoby -
