



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Moorestown Township in the County of Berk's (formerly Philadelphia) in the Province of Pennsylvania - Containing Fifty one acres and 153 Perches of Land. Together with the usual allowance of Six per Cent for Roads. That was formerly Surveyed By Edward Scull unto Casper Rapp, in Pursuance of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries Dated on the 28th October Anno 1746 - who afterwards sold the same to Conrad Bader - To whom it was resurveyed By Henry Vander Gluge - - - The above is drawn from his Draught on the 18th August Anno 1766.
