



Situate in Franklin late Monahan Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 7 a & 45 perches and allowe of land Being part of a larger Tract of 33 & 110 perches and allowe of Land which <sup>was</sup> originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D<sup>t</sup>. on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1783. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 30 a. Granted to Badger Mandy bearing date the 7<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1774. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the first day of December A.D. 1813. For and at the request of the owner Henry Miller, who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation, the 2<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1814. —
