Murray's Survey includes that part of the above survey north of the dotted line I should have thought it improper for me to have Executed Murray's Warrant on the above grounds but the claim by Virtue of an Improvement made prior to the date of the Warrant in the name of James Brady, you will find on Comparing the drafts that Murray's ~~Survey~~ Improvement is not on the above Survey nor was the land built at the time the above Survey was made =
