 ing as above set forth 146 perches and allowances &c. Surveyed on the
 20th day of July A.D. 1814, in Pursuance of a Warrant for 30th Granted
 to John Huber bearing date the 14th day of June A.D. 1814, N.B. The Im-
 provements on the above described Tract of Land at the time of Sur-
 veying, were a Plank House (or rather a Cabin) and some clear-
 ed Land rendering it an actual personal resident settle-
 ment with a manifest Intention of making it a place of abode
 and means of supporting a family and that the actual settle-
 ment appeared to have been commenced and made prior to the
 28th day of March last.
