Situate on the West Branch of a large Run which runs into the Kiskamimus River & East of said River on an Indian Path leading from the Kittanning to the Old Kiskamimus Town about eight Miles below the Mouth of Black Legs Creek in Westmoreland County - By Warrant of the 18th Day of October 1773.
