



By Virtue of a warrant dated the 11th September 1784 Surveyed the 20th November 1784 to John Lester the above Described Tract of Land, Situate on Shoholy creek four miles from the mouth in Northampton County containing Two hundred acres one hundred & fifty perches & the allowance of six yd Cent &c

N.B. The Identical Land mentioned in the Warrant was Surveyed to James Wells by Warrant of the 23^d Sept^r 1784 this Draught, is on the next vacancy on the Creek about a mile above
