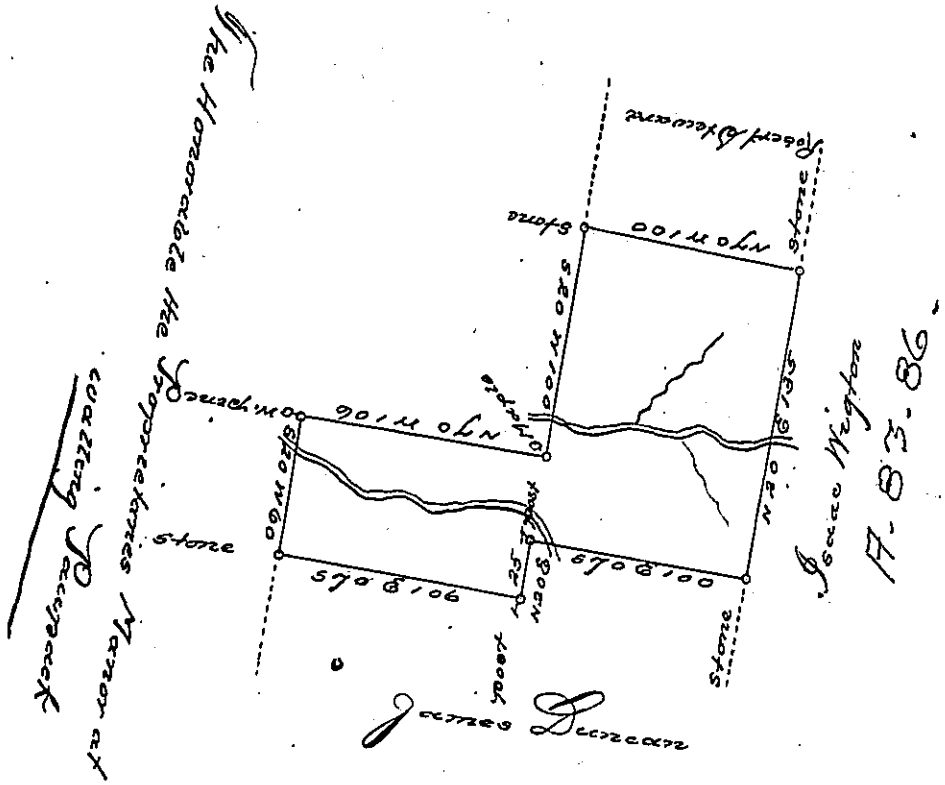


Palmyra -

Miller the above described tract of land situated on Bear and Bee Brook in the County of Northampton about one mile from Wilsons Hill. Containing one hundred and seventeen acres and the allowance of six per cent Bel.
