




A Draught of a Survey called The Addition lying on Coal Pitt Run, in Washington County, Cont<sup>g</sup> 64 Ac. & 78<sup>sq</sup>.<sup>rs</sup>. Strict measure, executed Feb<sup>y</sup>. 14<sup>th</sup>. 1786 in pursuance of a certificate in these words. "We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahela, Ohio & York" do hereby certify that Rob<sup>t</sup>. Rutherford Ass<sup>ee</sup> of Wm. Lindsey is entitled to two hundred Ac. of Land, Situated lying & being "in the County of York" on the waters of Coal Pitt Run, bounded by a "small Drain the line between the S. Robert Rutherford and Ad. Hickman to include his Settlement made in the year of our Lord 1775. Given under our hands at Redstone Old Fort this 19<sup>th</sup> of Nov 1779. in the fourth year of the Commonwealth. Teste J<sup>as</sup>. Chas<sup>es</sup> C<sup>lerk</sup> Com<sup>missioners</sup>"
