



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Farmers Choice, Situate on a Run Emptying into the West side of Clearfield Creek about fifteen Miles above the mouth of said Creek adjoining Land of Thomas Magee and Joseph Jones in Frankstown Township in the County of Bedford containing Three hundred & twenty <sup>seven</sup> Acres & the usual allowance of six p. Cent. for Roads &c. Surveyed the 30<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1776, for George James in pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 3<sup>d</sup> Day of August 1773, by Thomas Smith D.C.
