



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Marlborough Township in the County of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania, Containing twenty eight acres and 76 perches of Land together with the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads, That was formerly Surveyed to John Muck (a. Muck) By virtue of a warrant granted to him by the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries, Dated on the 14th June Anno. 1751. The said John Muck by his Deed Poll of the 12th December Anno. 1772, sold and conveyed his Right to the same, together with his other land, to Andrew Reed - Resurveyed for the said Andrew Reed on the 27th of February Anno. 1782.
