



The above is a Draught of a Survey made for James Roney the 26th day of January 1785. In pursuance of the herein annexed Certificate. Situate on the Waters of Wheeling in Washington County, called Star Fort, containing four hundred acres strict measured. We the Commissioners appointed to adjust the claims to Unpatented lands in the counties Monongahela York and Ohio do hereby certify that James Roney is entitled to four hundred acres of Land in the County of Ohio on Wheeling Creek to Include his Settlement made in the year 1774 Ent^d 6th June. 1780 — Given under our hands at Cinc. Fort the 24th day February 1780, in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
