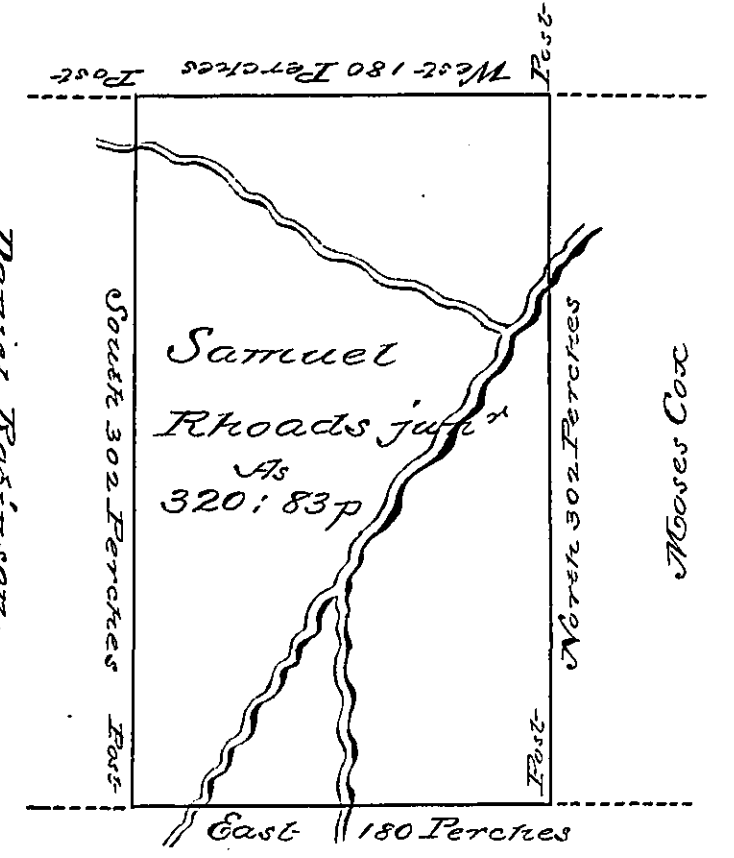

A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Chest Farm being part of a larger Tract of the same name situate on both sides - but mostly on the northwest side of the Chest Creek about half a mile above the first or lower forks of said Creek and about four or five miles above where the old Trading Path from Frankstown to the Kittanning crosses the said Creek adjoining and north of a Tract of Land Surveyed for Jabez Maud Fisher east of Daniel Robinson's Land & West of Moses Cox's Land in the County of Bedford Containing three hundred and twenty Acres & eighty three Perches and the usual Allowance of Six Acres for Roads &c Surveyed the 17th Day of June 1773 for Samuel Rhoads the younger in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him Dated the 27th Day of April in the same year by
