



By Virtue of a warrant from the Honble Proprietaries bearing Date the Eighteenth Day of October Anno 1738. I have surveyed and laid out unto Nicholas Clay one branch of Little Conewaga in the County of Lancaster on the West side Susquehanna river Two hundred and thirty three Acres of Land with Allowance of six P Cent in right of Henry Cline Beginning at a post a Corner of Matthias Uries land Thence North sixty Nine Degrees Easterly one hundred and two Perches to a post, Thence South Seventy Degrees Easterly Seventy five Perches to a Hickery thence North fifty five Degrees Easterly one hundred and twenty six Perches to a Hickery thence North sixty Degrees Westerly one hundred and sixty four Perches to a Post Thence North Eighty Degrees Westerly one hundred and sixty five Perches to a White Oak Thence South two Degrees Easterly two hundred Perches to a Hickery Thence South forty Nine Degrees Easterly twenty two Perches to the Place of Beginning
