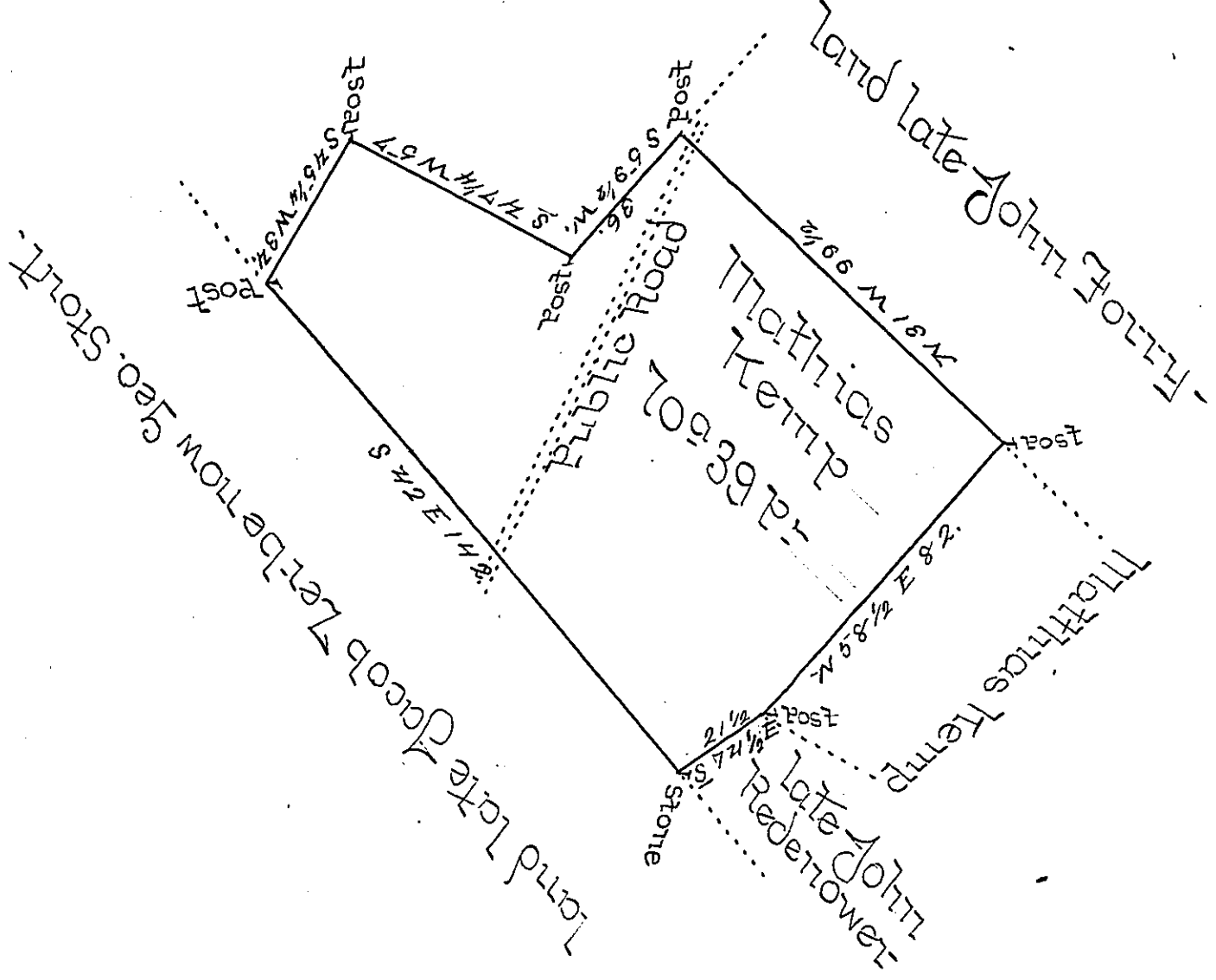


Nicholas Kowker
