



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Maccanry Township in the County of Northampton in the State of Pennsylvania containing forty four Acres and 20 Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at six per Cent for Roads. That was formerly surveyed by Order of James Soull to George Kerr [al. Gorr.] by Warrant of the 20th May Anno: 1770. But by a Resurvey it was found to differ a little with the former Draught: Resurveyed for the said George Kerr on the 22nd October Anno: 1783. =
