

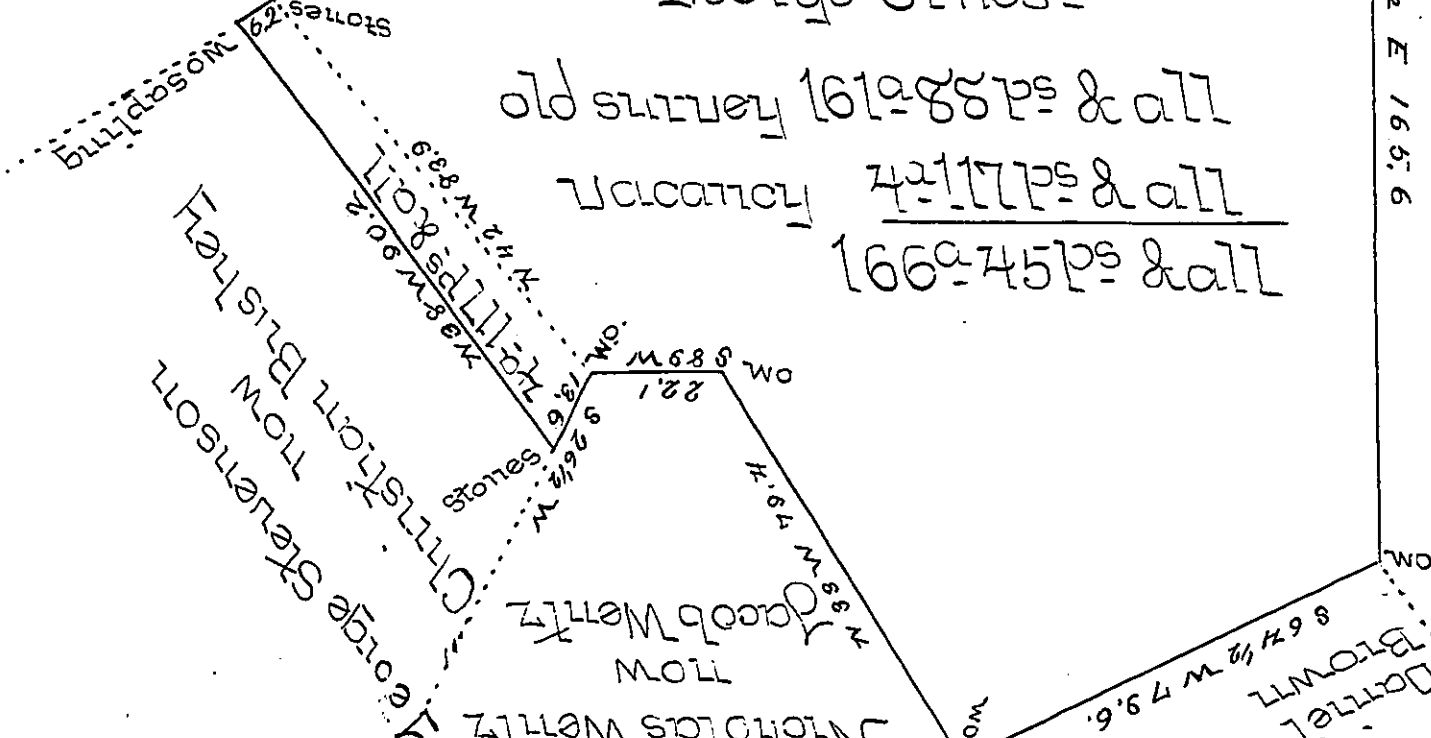

Situated in Reading Township & Adams County the part containing 161^a 88^ps & all was surveyed about 1766 or 1767 by Charles Lukens D.S. by an order of survey No 427 to George Ernest for 150^a dated 1st August 1766 Resurveyed April 15th & 16th of April 1807 including a small vacancy containing 4^a 117^ps & all lying between the survey made by Lukens for Ernest and Christian Bushey's land, Christian Bushey says his land was surveyed by John Forsyth D.S. and the vacancy excluded & found both the lines regularly marked many years ago the corners round the vacancy were all standing probably Bushey's is returned in the name of George Stevenson.
