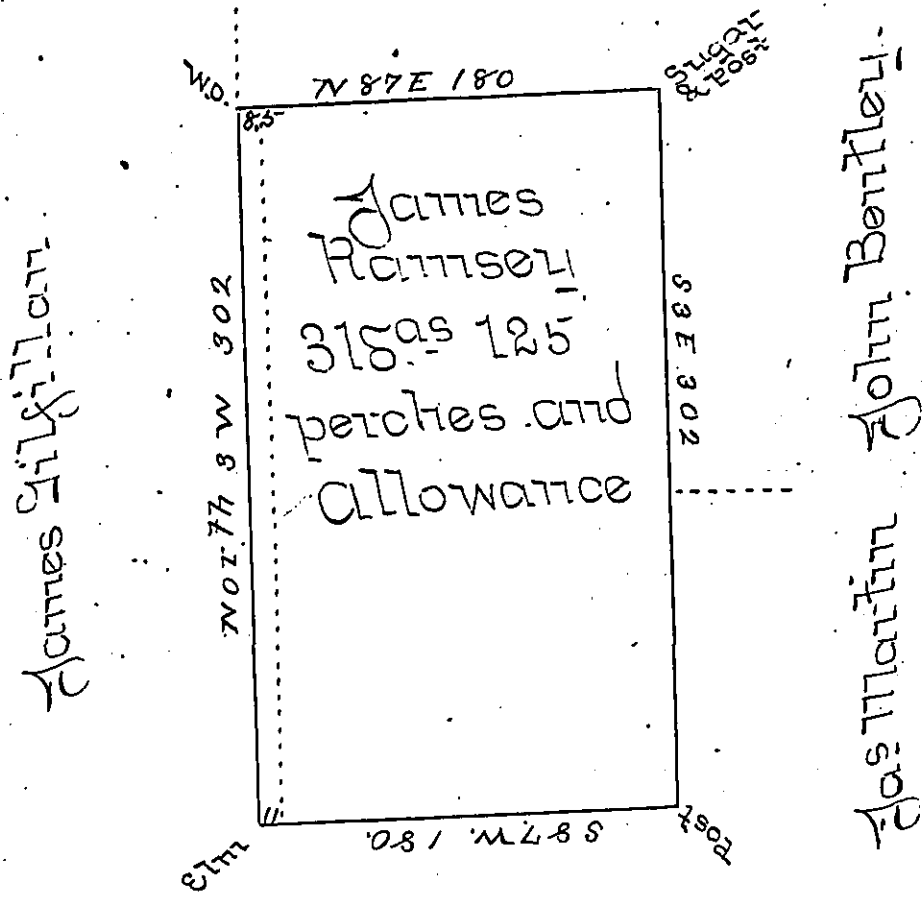


Heirs of Tho^s White
