



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 11th Day of June 1838 ----- In Pursuance of Instructions from the Surveyor General Situate on the Waters of Connequansing on the West side of the Ohio River in District No 2 being Part of the Land to be sold for the Redemption of the Depreciated Certificates Containing Two hundred Thirteen Acres Three Quarters & Thirty Eight Pole With Allowance of 6 P.C.
