



A Draught of a Tract of Land in Newberry Township and York County being part of a Tract of Land granted to a certain John Heald by Warrant of the first day of November 1735 and surveyed and Returned into the Surveyor Generals Office and Resurveyed and Two Hundred and Three Acres and Three Quarters and Allowance of 6 P: Ct &c (being Moiety there of) bounded and Described as above laid off to Ellis Lewis Pursuant to a Warrant from his Excellency W<sup>m</sup> Moore Esq<sup>r</sup> Presid<sup>t</sup> of the Supreme Executive Council bearing Date the 13<sup>th</sup> day of March 1782 Resurveyed March 27<sup>th</sup> 1782 Executed by Order of Survey Gen<sup>l</sup> to John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Survey Gen<sup>l</sup> Chas Lukens D.S.
