

A Draught of a Tract of Land Called Scotland, situate on Delaware Run adjoining land of Jacob Stout and others in Turbutt Township in the County of Northumberland, Surveyed on the 29th day of June 1769 by William Scull the then Deputy Surveyor of the District & Resurveyed by me on the 5th day of March 1785 for Thomas Kilcreast in Pursuance of his order of Survey No 946 bearing date the 3^d day of April 1769 - Containing Two Hundred and Eighty Three Acres & Three Quarters with the Allowance of six ¹⁰⁰/₁₀₀ for Roads &c.
