



A Drought of a Lot of ground situate on the North side of Penn Street in the Town of Reading in the County of Berks, marked in the General Plan of said Town No 170 containing in breadth East & West sixty feet and in length North & South 270 feet. Bounded Southward by Penn Street, Eastward by Lot No 171. Northward by a twenty foot Alley and Westward by Lot No 167. Surveyed and laid out the 10th January 1762 for the use of Jacob Dickis
