Cent for Roads &c. which appears to have been surveyed 15<sup>th</sup> November 1793 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Henry Drups dated the 29<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1792 The Original of which has been deliver<sup>d</sup> over to me by my Predecessor Sam<sup>l</sup> Lyon Esq<sup>r</sup> as an Office paper The survey must have been executed under the direction of Sam<sup>l</sup> Lyon Esq<sup>r</sup> who was the Deputy Surveyor of the District at the Date of the Survey
